- ***Temporary Assistance*** (TA) (Formerly known as Public Assistance, Welfare): Short-term help available for families and individuals, must meet income guidelines to receive money for basic living expenses
- ***Family Assistance*** (FA): Money for families with children
- ***Safety Net Assistance*** (SN): Money for single adults and childless couples
- ***Emergency Assistance for Adults*** (FAA): Short-term emergency needs of SSI recipients
- ***Emergency Assistance for Families*** (EAF): Short-term emergency needs for families with children
- ***Food Stamps***: Federal nutrition program which helps low-income individuals and families meet nutritional needs, must meet income guidelines
- ***Women, Infant, Children Program*** (WIC): Supplemental food program for eligible women, infants and children which also provides nutrition education and health screening ***1-800-522-5006***
- ***Medicaid***: Benefit program, which provides assistance with medical expenses for low-income families and individuals. Provides comprehensive health and dental

- services for eligible individuals and families. Doctor visits, in-patient hospital care, emergency services, prescription drugs, medical transportation are covered.
- **Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP):** Federally funded program that helps low income households pay home energy costs and fund programs for low cost residential weatherization and other energy related home repairs. Provides assistance to meet both non-emergency and emergency needs
  - **Child Support Services:** Child Support enforcement services, find a non-custodial parent, establish legal fatherhood of a child, obtain a support order from court, collect child support payments, enforce unpaid child support, review the support order for more support, take actions across state lines
  - **Refugee and Immigration Programs:** Resources to documented refugees to help achieve economic and social self sufficiency and to legal immigrant families to help in transition to life in a new country
    - Refugee Targeted Assistance Program (RETAP)

  - **Child Health Plus (CHPlus):** State-sponsored health insurance plan for children up to age 19 who are not eligible for Medicaid and who have no health insurance. Family premiums vary according to income. **CALL: 1-800-698-KIDS**
  - **Subsidized Child Care:** May be provided to enable a parent or caretaker to engage in work/school or other work-related activities
  - **Earned Income Tax Credit (EIC):** Refundable tax benefits for working people with low/moderate incomes
