WHAT IS A GRANT APPLICATION REVIEW PANEL?

United Way of the Greater Capital Region (UWGCR) invests in community programs and collaborations to MEET ESSENTIAL NEEDS, PROMOTE FINANCIAL STABILITY and STRENGTHEN INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES. These are the building blocks for a healthy community.

Volunteers are needed to serve on our annual grant application review panels. These panels help determine how UWGCR funding is best utilized. Panels review applications from human service programs and collaborations that address and impact community needs. There are two volunteer panel categories: single agency applications and collaborative applications.

VOLUNTEERS MATTER

Panel volunteers are the driving force of UWGCR's investments. As a review panel volunteer, you make a difference in your community by ensuring that effective, high performing community programs and collaborations continue their success through United Way investments. Volunteers receive application review training, must attend up to five subsequent weekly meetings, and reconvene to make final investment recommendations. Meetings take place from January—March with the final funding recommendation meeting taking place in April.
