- Photo identification for the person filing the tax return
- W-2, 1099 and other IRS forms as appropriate
- Bank account and routing numbers for direct deposit
- 2017 tax return (if available)
- Social Security card for each person listed on your tax form (yourself, spouse and any dependents)
- Form 1095-A, B or C (Health Insurance Marketplace Statement)
- Childcare documentation
- Unemployment forms

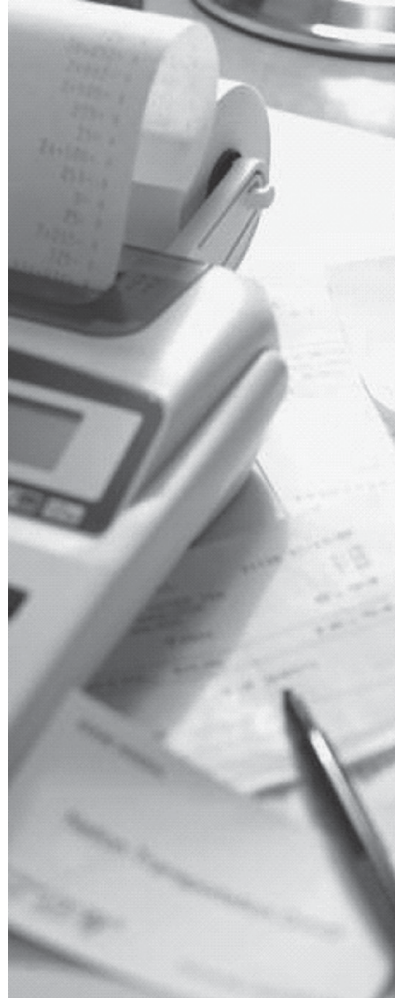
